In the study, data was collected by phone using CATI (Computer) Assisted Telephone Interview) method.


### **Data collection date**

## Distribution of the sample by district
















## **Do workplaces continue their activities?**

### Did employers reduce the number of employees?


They state that they had to reduce 25% when employers are asked in what direction their number of employees has changed in the last 1 month.





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

















# How have the people's subsistence changed after Covid-19?








## How did Covid-19 affect people's livelihoods?


